CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

FULL: Open to any person deemed capable of preparing an acceptable scientific paper on some subject of Astronomy or related branch of science. Supporting evidence for nomination should include one of the following:

- a) Ph.D. in Astronomy or closely related field.
- b) Independent or senior authorship of acceptable, refereed and published paper.
- c) Detailed evidence of significant contributions to Astronomy in forms other than research publication.

ASSOCIATE: Open to any person, 28 years of age or older who is no longer a student and has not obtained a Ph.D. in Astronomy or a related science. Should be actively involved in the advancement of Astronomy or a related science or be able to provide evidence of contributions to science.

JUNIOR: Open to persons who are either under 28 years of age and actively involved in the advancement of astronomy or a related science or a full time student, regardless of age, pursuing a degree in Astronomy or a related science at college level or higher. Full time students must provide proof of student status. Applicants to this class of membership must use the Junior membership application form.

INTERNATIONAL AFFILIATE: Open to astronomers or scientists in closely related fields who are not resident in the United States. Applicants require either nomination by an active full member of the AAS or must be members of an qualifying society that requires nomination for membership. Applicants to this class of membership must use the International Affiliate membership application form. Not eligible for discounts to printed versions of AAS journals.

EMERITUS: Open to any one who is retired from gainful employment and has been a member of the AAS for at least ten (10) years. Members promoted after 1 January 1998 pay ½ member dues rate, those promoted prior to this date pay no membership dues.
